

ORDINANCE NO. 1102

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE To ascertain, determine and declare a deficit on account of the improvement by C. E. Davis of Thurston Street from the North line of Ninth Street North to the South line of the Southern Pacific Railway Company, right of way in the City of Albany, Oregon, and to ascertain, re-assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such deficit that is re-assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to said Thurston Street and to direct the Recorder of the City of Albany to enter such deficit so levied in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS, On the 25th. day of July, 1923, the Council of the City of Albany passed Ordinance No. 1090 assessing upon lots, and parts thereof, adjacent to said Thurston Street, certain amounts for the improvement of said Thurston Street, and

WHEREAS, The said improvement has been completed and the contractor's final figures have been filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany and the City Council has settled with the contractor for said improvement, and

WHEREAS, It is found by the council that the Council that the sums assessed in said Ordinance upon the separate lots, or parts thereof adjacent to said Thurston Street, as directed in said Ordinance No. 1090 and each of them is insufficient to defray the cost of said improvement, and the total assessment as ascertained, assessed, determined and declared by said Ordinance No. 1090, is insufficient to pay the cost of said improvement by the sum of Sixty-two and Thirteen Hundredths Dollars (\$62.13) and that it is necessary to re-assess the said real property.

THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council hereby ascertains, determines and declares that there is a deficit in the assessment made in said Ordinance No. 1090, as against the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said Thurston Street in the sum of Sixty-two and Thirteen Hundredths Dollars (\$62.13) and that there be and is hereby re-assessed the same to be in excess of the original assessment against the several parcels of land, whose owners, or reputed owners, together with the description of the property assessed, as owned by each of them respectively, with the amount of such assessment charged to each of them respectively as follows:
