ORDINANCE NO. 1166

AN ORDINANCE prohibiting dogs from running at large within the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing ~~for~~ a penalty for a violation hereof, and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1.--

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation being the owner or custodian of any dog to permit such dog to run at large upon any of the public streets, alleys or other public places within the City of Albany, Oregon, or upon the premises of any person except the premises owned or controlled by the owner or custodian of such dog.

Section 2.--

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction before the Recorder's Court, be punished by fine of not more than \$25.00.

Section 3.--

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and no ordinance heretofore repealed shall be revived by reason of the adoption of this ordinance.
