## ORDINANCE NO 1284

AN ORDINANCE muthorizing the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a Jontract with C.E.Davis for the improvement of Second Street from the west line of Cleveland Street to the Wast line of Geary Street in the City of Albany by grading and graveling the same.

WHENSAS, by Ordinance Number 1181 of the City of Albany. Oregon, it was ordered that the following Street in said Street in said City, be improved, towit: Second Street from the west line of Cheveland Street to the West Line of Geary Street, in the following manner, towit:

18t: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.
2nd: By surfacing the roadway of said Street 12 feet wide with gravel.
3rd: By laying sub-grade tile.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany, and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the Recorder of said City: and

WHEREAS, it was provided in said Ord@Ance that the Recorder of said City give notice of the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law, and in said Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, after due notice for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany, according to the law and the ordinance aforesaid, towit: on the 27th day of May. 1925, C.K.Davis presented to the Council of the City of Albany his bid for making said improvement, which said bid was and is, in due form, and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by the Council, by which said bid the said C.K.Davis proposed to furnish all material and implements and to performathe labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the following named prices, towit:

218 yde. of excavation, (without classification) @ 800 per cu.yd.\$174.40
77 6u. yds. of fill.

200 cu. yds. gravel

(21.40 per cu.yd. 23.10

@ 30c.per cu.yd. 23.10 @1.40 per cu.yd. 280.00 @ 25c per lin. ft 20.00 200 cu. yds. gravel 80 lines! feet of 3 inch drain tile

And, WHEREAS, the said C.E.Davis was the lowest and best bidder for said proposed work, and said bid was the losest and best bid therefor.

THEHRFORE

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBARY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of C.R.Davis for said improvement of said described portion of Second Street be, and the same is hereby, accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder of the said City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said C.R.Davis for the making of said improvement, on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in the said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract shall provide that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten (10) days after the signing of said contract, and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that will the work embraced within said contract shall be completed on or before the first day of August, 1925, and the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per day for os deemed to suffer damages to the extent of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per day for each and every day such work is delayed beyond such specified time, and that the said C.E.Davis shall furnish a bond in the sum of Four Hundred Dollare (\$400.00), to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, conditioned for the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of said C.W.Davis, and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.

Section 2. That in order to preserve the public health and safety of the City of Albany an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and upon approval by the Mayor.
