

ORDINANCE No. 1185

AN ORDINANCE to ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined to make in Resolution No. 5, adopted by said Council on the 11th day of March, 1925, on Second Street, from the west line of Cleveland Street to the west line of Geary Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said portion of said Street, that is assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to said portion of Second Street to be so improved; to authorize and direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the docket of City Liens, as provided by the charter of said City; and declaring an emergency:

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of March, 1925, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution requiring Charles H. Leonard, Engineer, to compile and file in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 11th day of March, 1925, plans, specifications and estimates of the probable cost of making the improvement of Second Street in said City from the west line of Cleveland Street to the west line of Geary Street, by grading and graveling the same; and

WHEREAS, said engineer, pursuant to said Resolution, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed thereby for the improvement of said Second Street, and filed the same in the office of the Recorder of said City, on the 11th day of March, 1925, and

WHEREAS, the Council of said City on the 11th day of March, 1925, by resolution No. 5 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that the Council proposed to improve Second Street from the west line of Cleveland Street to the west line of Geary Street in said City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 5, and

WHEREAS, in and by said Resolution No. 5 the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Second Street from the west line of Cleveland Street to the west line of Geary Street, as provided by the charter and ordinances of said City, and

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council, did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Second Street in the manner provided by said Resolution, and the charter and ordinances of said City, and

WHEREAS, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 5 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Second Street, to be paid by the owners of the real property, adjacent to said portion of said Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 5 to be the sum of FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-ONE and 28/100 DOLLARS (\$491.28), and

WHEREAS, by ordinance No. 1184, after due notice of the time and in the manner provided by law the bid of C.W. Davis for the making of said improvement of said portion of Second Street, was accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany were thereby authorized to enter into a contract with C.W. Davis for the making of said improvement in accordance with said bid, by grading and graveling said portion of said Street, and in other respects in accordance with said Resolution No. 5.

WHEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Second Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the west line of Cleveland Street to the west line of Geary Street, shall be improved as follows:

- 1st: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.
- 2nd: By surfacing the roadway of said street 12 feet wide with gravel;
- 3rd: By laying sub-drain tile;

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 5, and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by Charles H. Leonard, City Engineer, with the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 11th day of March, 1925.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Second Street, from the west line of Cleveland Street to the west line of Geary Street, in said City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner heretofore determined by the Council and in and by said Resolution No. 5, to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of Second Street, is hereby declared to be the sum of FOUR HUNDRED NINETY ONE and 28/100 DOLLARS (491.28).

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Second Street, assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to said portion of Second Street to be improved as aforesaid, and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 5, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of such lots, or parts thereof, as follows:

That the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby ordered and directed to immediately enter a statement of the assessments hereby made and declared by this ordinance, together with the names of the respective owners of such lot or part thereof, hereinabove described, in the Docket of City Liens in the City of Albany, as provided in the charter of said City.

Section 5. That in order to preserve the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany, and of its inhabitants, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.


