ORDINANCE NO. 1196

AN ORDINANCE providing for the time and manner of building and constructing a lateral sewer, beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street trunk sewertetween Sixth and Seventh Streets, and running thence westerly through block two (2) and into block One (1), in Hacklemen's Heir's First Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, a distance of 5/8 lineal feet, providing how the cost of said improvement shell be paid, the penalty or immage to the City of Albany by the person, or persons, making said improvement, if the same on not completed at the time agreed upon, and the giving of good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement, and providing for the giving of notice for bids for making of said improvement, by the accorder of the City of Albany, Oregon.

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALREAY DO CADATA AS FOLLOWS:

* Rection 1. That there shall be constructed an 8 inch vitrified terra cotta sewer beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street trunk sewer between Sixth and Seventh Streets, and running thence westerly through Block Two (2) and into Block One (1) in Hacklessan's Heirs First Addition to the City of Alonny, Oregon, a distence of 570 fest.

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications of the City Engineer of said City, for the construction of said lateral sewer, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City May 13, 1925.

The cost of said interal sewer shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising out of the assessment to be made, ascertained and declared by Ordinance No. on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said improvement so to be made, and especially and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by/the charter of said City.

Said sewer shall be completed by the first lay of September, 1925.
All bids submitted for the laking of said improvement deemed unreasonable by buncil of the City of Albany, hay be rejected.

All bids submitted for the laking of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany, may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City for the making of said improvement shall, before the commencing of said improvement, and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient surety, to be approved by the mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, in a sum equal to fifty per cent(50%) of the amount, to be paid for the faithful performance of said contract.

If the firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the City of Alomny to make said improvement small not complete the same in the time mentioned and specificed in and contract, said City small be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to emeasure of Five Dollars (55.00) per day for each and every my the completion of said work is relayed beyond the ine time so stated in said contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time for the completion thereof be extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is dereby directed to immediately give proper notice of bids for the making of such improvement by publication of such Tor ten (10) days in the Albany Democrat-Herald, a daily newspaper published in the City of Albany, Oregon, describing in such notice the time and manner of doing such improvement.
