THEREFORY, THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of U.G. Hayne for said improvement of said dea stribed portion of Sherman Street, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the layor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract, in writing, with the said U.G. Hayne for the making of said improvement with concrete pavement, on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, and upon the terms mentioned in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract shall provide that the work " said improvement shall commence within ten (10) days after the signing of said contract, and shall be pros-scuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in raid contract shall be enscuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in rais contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 18th day of October, 1925, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of Ign Dollars (\$10.00) per day for each and every day the work is islayed beyon? Decided time, and that the said U.G. Hayne shall furnish a bond in the said of TUELUN INTILLY and no/100 DOLLARS (\$1200.00), to be approved by the Layor of the City of Albany, Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of said U.G.
