

ORDINANCE NO. 1218

AN ORDINANCE making, determining, and declaring and levying a tax for the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, a municipal corporation, upon the current assessment made upon the taxable property of said City for the year 1925, and to separately appropriate for each office, officer, department, building, structure, institution, bridge, road, highway, street, and other purposes the amount of the taxes so levied.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, does hereby make, ascertain, determine and declare the amount of taxes to be levied upon the assessment for the year 1925 of the taxable property in the City of Albany, and the taxes to be collected in the year 1926 in said City to be as follows, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 1218

Said tax shall be levied upon the assessed valuation of all assessable property, both real and personal, in said City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, as shown upon the assessment roll of Linn County, Oregon, which said assessment was made in the year 1925.

Section 2. That from the funds derived from the levy hereby made and determined there is hereby appropriated for the year 1926 the sum set opposite each of the respective items hereinabove set forth.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately notify the County Clerk and County Assessor of Linn County, Oregon, of this levy, as provided by law.


