## ORDINANCE NO. 1888

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with W.W.Head Construction Co., for the improvement of Righth Street from the west line of Ellsworth Street to the east line of Eroadalbin Street and from the west line of Broadalbin Street to the east line of Ferry Street in said City:

WHREAS, by Ordinance No. 1249 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following street in said City be improved, to-wit; Righth Street from the west line of Ellsworth Street to the east line of Broadalbin Street and from the west line of Broadalbin Street to the east line of Ferry Street, except a strip 36 feet wids, being 18 feet on each side of the center line of Eighth Street and extending the full length of the improvement, in the following manner:

1st: By grading said portion of said street to the proper sub-grade;
2nd: By paving the rodway of said portion of said Street (according to plans and specifications) with Portland cement concrete pavement.

3rd: By laying and constructing pavement headers;

4th: By constructing concrete curbs wherever necessary;

5th: By constructing oatch basins and inlets;

Sth: By laying vitrified sewer pipes;
Said improvement to be made in accordance with Charter and Ordinances of the
City of Albany, and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer

WHEREAS, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany and

bany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided

by law and by said ordinance, and

WHRHAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids, made and given by the new corder of the City of Albany according to law and the ordinances aforesaid, to-wit: on the 9th day of June, 1927, W.W. Head Construction Co. presented to the Council of the City of Albany its bid for making said improvement with concrete pavement, which said bid was in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid said W.W. Head Construction Co. proposed to furnish all material and implements and to perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with concrete payement for the following named prices, to-wit: 333 cubic yards of excavation (without classification) including fine grading and rolling, 2 70c per cu.yd - - \$233.10 1192 sq yds. of concrete payement (see plans for thickness, 2 \$2.04 per sq. yd 32431.68

And, WHIREAS, said W.W. Head Construction Co. was the lowest and best bidder for said proposed work, and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor,

THEREFORE THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of W.W. Head Construction Co. for said improvement of said described portion of Righth Street be and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said W.W. Head Construction Co. for the making of said improvement with cement pavement on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract shall provide that the work of said improvement shall commence within 10 days after the signing of said contract, and shall be prosecuted with such within 10 days after the signing of said contract, and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 10th day of August, 1927, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the W.V. Head Construction Co. shall furnish a bond in the sum of 31332.39, to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of said d.W. Head Construction Co., and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm, person or corporation, arising out of said contract.
