

ORDINANCE NO. 1283

AN ORDINANCE to assess the cost of the construction of a sidewalk on the north side of Third Street, adjacent to the south half of the southwest quarter of block No. 127 in Hackleman's Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon.

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of February, 1928, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Albany, Oregon, reported in writing to the Council of said City that a sidewalk should be constructed along the north side of Third Street and adjacent to the south half of the southwest quarter of block No. 127 in Hackleman's Addition to said City, which said report is now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany in and by Resolution No. 25, passed by the Council February 8th, 1928, required Fanny Hostetler, the reputed owner of said property, to construct a sidewalk along said Third Street adjacent to the south half of the southwest quarter of block 127 in Hackleman's Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and that said sidewalk be constructed within thirty (30) days from the adoption of said resolution, and

WHEREAS, the said Fanny Hostetler was duly and regularly notified in the manner required by the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany of the adoption of said Resolution, and further notified that in the event she should fail to construct said sidewalk within thirty (30) days from the date of the adoption of said resolution that the City of Albany would cause said sidewalk to be constructed and would assess the cost thereof against the real property abutting thereon, and

WHEREAS, the said Fanny Hostetler did fail, neglect and refuse to construct or cause to be constructed said sidewalk, or any part thereof, within the time required by said Resolution No. 25, and at any other time, and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Albany after the expiration of the period of thirty (30) days, as provided by said Resolution No. 25, did proceed to construct said sidewalk and has reported to the Council that said sidewalk has been constructed and that he has also submitted a full and complete report of the cost of the construction thereof, said report showing the same to have cost the sum of \$117.20.

THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the cost of constructing the sidewalk along the north side of Third Street adjacent to the south half of the southwest quarter of block No. 127 in Hackleman's Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby ascertained, determined and declared to be the sum of \$117.20, which said sum is hereby assessed upon and declared to be a lien against said property.

Section 2. That the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter in the docket of city liens the said sum of \$117.20 as a lien against the property described in Section 1 hereof, the name of the owner, or reported owner, being Fanny Hostetler.
