

ORDINANCE NO. 1332

A n ordinance requiring all persons, firms and corporations operating urban passenger buses upon and along the streets, avenues, thoroughfares and public highways on a time schedule and over fixed termini, within the limits of the City of Albany, Oregon, to first obtain a franchise from said City for such purpose, and providing a penalty for violation hereof.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate an urban passenger bus business upon and along the streets, avenues, thoroughfares and public highways on a time schedule and over fixed termini within the limits of the City of Albany, Oregon, without first having obtained from said City a franchise for the operation of such urban passenger bus business in said City.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court shall be <sup>punished</sup> ~~fine~~ by a fine of not more \$10.00 or by imprisonment in the City jail for a period not to exceed five days.
