

ORDINANCE No. 1344

An ordinance appropriating the sum of \$385.31 of the street fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, to defray the cost of the purchase price of a quantity of street signs and authorizing the Recorder of said City to draw a warrant against the street fund payable to Irwin-Hodson Co. in the sum of \$385.31 in payment thereof.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the street fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of \$385.31 for the purpose of defraying the cost of the purchase price of a quantity of street signs heretofore ordered of Irwin-Hodson Co.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to the said Irwin-Hodson Co. a street fund warrant of the City of Albany in the sum of \$385.31 in payment of the street signs hereinabove referred to.


