

ORDINANCE NO. 1354

An ordinance regulating the parking of motor vehicles upon the public streets of the City of Albany in front of the main entrance of public theater buildings and providing a penalty for violation hereof.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave standing and unattended any motor vehicle directly in front of the main entrance of any public theater in the City of Albany except for the purpose of receiving or discharging passengers, baggage or merchandise therefrom, and at no time for any period longer than five minutes for each of such vehicles, provided that this ordinance shall apply only to such hours when said public theater shall be open for business and for a period of one hour before such opening and one hour after the closing of its doors to the public.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the recorder's Court, be punished by a fine of not more than \$25.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail not to exceed 12 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.


