

ORDINANCE No. 1357

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Treasurer of the City of Albany, Oregon, to transfer the surplus funds now in the Old Bridge Refunding Bond to the Bond Interest Fund of said City.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Whereas, the bond issue of the City of Albany known as the Old Bridge Refunding Bond issue has been fully paid, together with all interest and other charges chargeable against said fund; and

Whereas, there is now a balance in said fund amounting to the sum of \$1175.76, which said sum is not needed and will never be used for the purposes for which it was created.

Therefore, the Treasurer of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to transfer said fund of \$1175.76 to the Bond Interest Fund of said City.


