

ORDINANCE No. 1359

An ordinance providing for the construction of a ten inch main sewer in the City of Albany, Oregon, beginning at the manhole in Maple Street trunk sewer between 9th and 10th Streets in said City and extending southerly a distance of 450 feet, providing for the manner in which the same may be constructed, how the costs of the same shall be paid and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Albany deem it expedient and necessary that a sewer be constructed, beginning at the manhole in Maple Street trunk sewer between 9th and 10th Streets in the City of Albany and extending southerly a distance of 450 feet for the purpose of providing adequate drainage for the territory immediately surrounding said proposed sewer; and

WHEREAS, the Council upon careful investigation finds that the work of constructing said sewer can be done by the City's own force account at a less cost to the City than by letting a contract for same to private contractors.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council deem it expedient that said sewer be constructed by its own force account and in the manner provided by the charter in such cases made and provided and according to the plans and specifications therefor now on file in the office of the Recorder of said City.

THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby authorized and directed to construct a ten-inch main sewer beginning at the manhole in Maple Street trunk sewer between 9th and 10th Streets in said City, and extending southerly a distance of 450 feet. Said sewer shall be made and constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications of Charles H. Leonard, engineer, for the construction of said sewer, which said plans and specifications are now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany. The cost of constructing said sewer shall be paid for from the general funds of the City of Albany heretofore appropriated by the Council for sewer purposes.

Section 2. That said sewer shall be constructed under the supervision of Chas. H. Leonard engineer of said City for the construction of said sewer, and said Council shall by and through said engineer have power and authority to purchase and hold utensils, machinery and material and/or to hire and/or rent the same and to hire and discharge servants and laborers and to do any and all things necessary in the construction of said sewer that an individual contractor might do. Said engineer shall keep an accurate account of all expenses fully itemized in making said improvement and shall report the same to the Council from time to time during the progress of the work and upon the approval thereof by the Council the Recorder is hereby authorized to draw warrants against general fund of said City in payment of said items of expense so approved.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany require that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and an emergency does exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
