

ORDINANCE NO. 1380

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor and the Recorder to enter into a contract with C.E.Davis for the repair of certain paved streets within the City of Albany and appropriating money from the street fund for payment of the contract price for such work.

WHEREAS, bids have heretofore been received by the Council for work and materials for the repairs of certain portions of the paved streets within the City of Albany, and the bid of C.E.Davis for said work and materials has been awarded to said C.E.Davis, which said bid is now on file in the Recorder's office in said City.

THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid aforesaid of said C.E.Davis for the repair of certain paved streets of the City of Albany, to be designated by the Council, be, and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said C.E.Davis upon the terms mentioned in said bid, and as follows, to-wit:

- (a) Base patching \$3.00 per sq. yard
- (b) Skin patching .45 " " "
- (c) Resurfacing with flush coating .09 " " "

Section 2. That the expense of making said repairs under said contract shall be paid from the street fund of said City, upon the completion thereof by the street fund warrants of said City, to be drawn by the Recorder and when authorized by the Council.
