

ORDINANCE No. 1401

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, to purchase of Alexander Motor Company, one Ford V-8 2-door sedan for the police department of said city, and appropriating the sum of \$613.00 in payment thereof, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Albany is hereby authorized to purchase of the Alexander Motor Company one Ford V-8 2-door sedan automobile for the use of the police department of said city at and for the agreed price of \$613.00.

Section 2. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the general fund of said city, and from that portion of said fund heretofore provided for emergency purposes, the sum of \$613.00 to be used in payment of the purchase price of the automobile referred to in Section 1 of this ordinance. When the invoice therefor shall have been properly presented to and allowed by the Council as a valid claim against the City, then the Recorder shall be authorized to make, execute and deliver to the said Alexander Motor Company the general fund warrant of said city in the amount of said claim allowed, but not to exceed the amount hereby appropriated.

Section 3. Whereas the peace health and safety of the people of the City of Albany require that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
