

ORDINANCE NO. 1402

AN ORDINANCE TO appropriate the sum of \$323.50 of the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, for the purpose of painting and kalsomining the City Hall Building of said city.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated of the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of \$323.50 to be used for the purpose of painting and kalsomining the City Hall Building of said city.

Section 2. That upon the proper presentation to and the allowance of the claim or claims for the work and materials so furnished in the purpose set forth in section 1 hereof by the Council, then the recorder shall pay the same by executing and delivering to the person or persons entitled thereto the general fund warrant or warrants of said city of Albany.
