

ORDINANCE NO. 1455

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of \$270.00 from the General Fund of the City of Albany to purchase one Chevrolet Automobile for the Police Department of said City and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there by and is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the City of Albany the sum of \$270.00 for the purchase of one Chevrolet Automobile for the use of the Police Department of said City.

Section 2. The Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to issue a general fund warrant in the sum of \$270.00, payable to the Don Densmoor Chevrolet Company for the purchase hereinabove set forth.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
