

ORDINANCE NO. 1465

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of \$3985.00 for the purpose of purchasing a street maintainer for the Street Department of the City of Albany, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of \$3985.00 for the purpose of purchasing a street maintainer of Howard-Cooper Corporation for the Street Department of the City of Albany.

Section 2. That upon the delivery of said street maintainer and the due acceptance thereof by the Committee of Street and Public Property the Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized to draw a warrant on the Street Fund in favor of the Howard-Cooper Corporation in the amount hereby appropriated.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
