

ORDINANCE NO. 1498

AN ORDINANCE to regulate the use of water from the waterworks during the time of fire.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Upon an alarm of fire being given, it shall be the duty of any and all persons using or taking water from the pipes of the Mountain States Power Company, of Albany, Oregon, immediately to shut off the flow of water from all hydrants, faucets, water closets, bathrooms, or other places on their respective premises where water is used, and to keep the same shut off, except when it is absolutely necessary to use water, until the fire is extinguished and the further use of water for fire purposes is not required. Any person or persons failing, neglecting, or refusing to comply with the provisions of this section, or in any way violating the same, shall, upon conviction thereof before the recorder's court of said city, be fined not less than \$5 or more than \$20, or be imprisoned in the city jail not less than 2 nor more than 10 days.
