

## ORDINANCE NO. 1537.

A Bill for

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of \$600.00 from the General Funds of the City of Albany heretofore provided for in the 1941 Fire Department Budget, in payment of the purchase price of 500 feet of 2½ inch hose, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General Funds of the City of Albany the sum of \$600.00 heretofore provided for in the 1941 Fire Department Budget in payment of the purchase price of 500 feet of 2½ inch hose, said hose having heretofore been ordered and received from the Eureka Fire Hose Division of the United States Rubber Company, and the Recorder of said City is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the General Fund Warrant of said City payable to said company in said amount,

Section 2. Whereas, the peace, health, and safety of the People of the City of Albany is involved, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
