

ORDINANCE NO. 1567

A Bill for

An ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of \$2840.00 of the General Funds of the City of Albany for the purchase of one two-way Police Radio System, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General Funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of \$2840.00 for the payment of the purchase price of one two-way Police Radio System recently purchased of the Galvin Mfg. Corp. to whom the Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the General Fund warrant of the City of Albany.

Section 2. WHEREAS the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Albany is envolved, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.
