

ORDINANCE NO. 1572

A Bill for

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of \$514.50 of the General Funds of the City of Albany to pay the cost of painting and decorating the interior of the City Hall Building of said City.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of \$514.50 of the General Funds of the City of Albany to pay the cost of painting and redecorating the interior of the City Hall Bldg. and the City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to issue the General Fund warrant of said City in said amount, payable to J. E. Gentry, the contractor heretofore engaged to do the work.
