

ORDINANCE No. 1595

A Bill for an ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$2, 058.70 of the special state tax street fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, for the purpose of purchasing from the Columbia Equipment Company one air compressor equipped with the paving breaker and other equipment for the Street Department of the City of Albany.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the special state tax street fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of \$2, 058.70 for the purpose of purchasing from the Columbia Equipment Company one air Compressor equipped with paving breaker and other equipment for the use of the Street Department of the City of Albany.

Section 2. The Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant against the special state tax street fund of said City in the sum of \$2,058.70, it being the amount appropriated for the purposes hereinabove set forth, and to deliver the same to the Columbia Equipment Company in payment of the equipment described in Section 1 of this Ordinance.
