

## A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE providing for the time and manner of vacating a portion of 17th Street in the City of Albany, Oregon which portion of said Street extends from the West line of Thurston St. to the east line of Lot 5, Block 9, in Hackleman's Sunrise Addition.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, are hereby authorized and directed to proceed to vacate a portion of 17th street which portion of said street extends from the west line of Thurston St to the east line of Lot 5, in Block 9 in Hackleman's Sunrise Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of the vacation of said portion of said street by publishing the same in Greater Oregon, a newspaper of general circulation published within said city, once each week, for four successive weeks, which said notice shall describe the portion of said street herein proposed to be vacated and that the council of the City of Albany, Oregon, will, on the 12th day of June, 1946, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. on said day, at the City Council Chambers of the City of Albany, Oregon hear objections or remonstrances to the vacation of said portion of said street by any person or persons interested therein and particularly by the owners of the real property affected thereby. Also, the Recorder of said City, within five days after the first publication of said notice, shall post at or near each end of said portion of said street herein proposed to be vacated, a copy of said notice which shall be headed "NOTICE OF STREET VACATION" and such notice which shall also be posted in at least two conspicuous places within the termini of said portion of said street. The posting and first day of publication of such notice shall not be less than twenty-eight days before the time of such hearing as hereinabove stated.

Section 3. WHEREAS, the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this Ordinance shall become immediately effective; THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become in full force and effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
