

ORDINANCE NO. 1710

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE vacating Eighth Street, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, from the East line of Maple Street to the West line of Vine Street in said City.

WHEREAS by Ordinance No. 1673 passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 13th day of March, 1946 it was provided for the time and manner of vacating Eighth Street from the East line of Maple Street to the West line of Vine Street in the City of Albany, Oregon:

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to said Ordinance, the Recorder gave notice of the vacation of said portion of said street for the time and in the manner provided by law and said Ordinance and in said notice it was provided that May 22nd, 1946, at seven o'clock P.M. of said day be the time set for the hearing of objections to the vacation of said portion of said street and this being the time and date set for said hearing and no objections and remonstrances being made or filed to said vacation or any portion thereof.

THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Eighth Street from the East line of Maple Street to the West line of Vine Street in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated.
