

ORDINANCE NO. 1762

A Bill For:

AN ORDINANCE to prevent the rebate or refunding of money paid for a fee or license, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That hereafter there shall be no rebate allowed upon any fee required or any license issued or to be issued by the City of Albany for any purpose, and no money paid or to be hereinafter paid for any such fee or any such license, nor any part thereof, shall hereafter be refunded because said license is surrendered, or application withdrawn or denied, or for any reason whatever.

Section 2. That all ordinances or provisions contained in any ordinance in conflict hereto are repealed and amended to conform with the provisions contained herein.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Albany are involved. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
