

ORDINANCE NO. 1777

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$392.00 out of the General Fund of the City of Albany to be used in payment for 56 tables, and authorizing payment of the same to Elmo G. McReynolds.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, and charged to the Park Improvement Fund, the sum of \$392.00, it being the price heretofore agreed upon, with Elmo G. McReynolds, for 56 tables, as shown by the invoice therefore now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to execute and deliver to Elmo G. McReynolds the General Fund Warrant of the City of Albany in payment of the amount and for the purpose of the appropriation as hereinabove set forth. That the amount hereby appropriated shall be charged against the Park Improvement Fund of said City.
