ORDINANCE NO. 1965

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A SURPLUS AND A DEFICIT ON ACCOUNT OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF WALNUT STREET BETWEEN QUEEN AVENUE AND 19th AVENUE; 18th AVENUE FROM MAPLE STREET TO ELM STREET AND MAPLE STREET FROM QUEEN STREET TO 18th STREET, IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, LIN COUNTY, OREGON, BY KEEBLER CONSTRUCTION CO., AND DIRECTING THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO PLACE TO THE CREDIT OR DEBIT OF TEN SEVERAL OWNERS OF THE VARIOUS PARCELS OF REAL ESTATE ADJACENT TO SAID IMPROVEMENT HERETOFORE ASSESSED AND ENTERED ON THE RECORD IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIENS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON FOR THE MAKING OF SAID IMPROVEMENT, THEIR PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH SURPLUS OR DEFICIT.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a surplus of \$771.81 and a deficit of \$685.42 is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract heretofore entered into, by and between the City of Albany, Oregon and Keebler Construction Co. for the improvement of Walnut Street between Queen Avenue and 19th Avenue; 18th Avenue from Maple Street to Elm Street and Maple Street from Queen to 18th Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate adjacent to said improvement heretofore assessed for the making of said improvement.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the Docket of City Liens for said City, in the surplus column and deficit column thereof, in the sum of \$771.81 and \$685.42 respectively, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed for making such improvement, and entered therein to defray the cost of the improvement, of said street, said surplus and deficit parcels of real estate, and in the sums as follows, to-wit:
