

ORDINANCE NO. 1971

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2. OF ORDINANCE NO. 1681 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC, AND REGULATING USE OF PUBLIC STREETS IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON; DEFINING AND ESTABLISHING PARKING METER ZONES AND REGULATING AND CONTROLLING AND PROVIDING FOR INSPECTION OF THE TIME PARKING OF VEHICLES THEREIN BY THE USE OF PARKING METERS; PRESCRIBING LIMITS OF TIME FOR PARKING IN PARKING METER ZONES, AND PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE AND PUNISHMENT FOR ITS VIOLATION", AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 2 which refers to the portions of street hereby established as parking meter zones shall include in such zone the following described portions of street:

Beginning at the north side of the alley between 3d and 4th Street on the east side of Lyon and extending approximately 50 feet north.

Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate health and safety of the citizens and inhabitants of the city of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the common council of the city of Albany, Oregon, and its approval by the mayor of said city.
