

ORDINANCE NO. 1997

AN ORDINANCE VACATING LIBERTY STREET FROM THE NORTH LINE OF EIGHTH STREET TO THE SOUTH LINE OF SEVENTH STREET IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON

WHEREAS, the City Council on July 28, 1948 authorized and directed the Recorder to advertise a proposal to vacate Liberty Street from the north line of Eighth Street to the south line of Seventh street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, and setting the time for remonstrances to be received until 7:30 p.m., May 25, 1949; and

WHEREAS, notice was duly published four (4) successive weeks in the Albany Democrat-Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in Albany, Oregon, and that proof of the publication is on file in the office of the Recorder, and no remonstrances having been received, no reason manifestly exists why said vacation of the street should not be allowed,

THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Liberty Street from the north line of Eighth Street to the south line of Seventh Street, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated.
