## ORDINALCE NO. 1998

## An ordinance to amend:

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE INTENTIO. OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, ORIGON TO ESTABLISH, OPERATE AND A TAIN, AT IN AND WITHOUT THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, DREGON, A SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT OR PLANT, OR THE CONFIDENCE SEVER SYSTEM AND DEPOSAL PLANT OR PLANT FOR A COMPLET SEVER SYSTEM AND DEPOSAL PLANT OR PLANTS. I POSING AN EQUITABLE CHARGE, DECLARING A CHRISTIN ACTS UNLAMPUL AND IMPOSING PENALTIES AND DECLARING TEMERCHICY.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 1960 as previously amended by Ordinance No. 1975 be further amended so that Section 4 thereof shall read as follows:

Section 4. The City of Albany is hereby directed to collect the rates and charges provided shell from each owner of property which disposes of sewage, whether in the city system or otherwise and on the first aw of each month, beginning and after the effective date hereof, each owner shall be charged the rate set out in section 3. Said charges, as and when collected, shall be paid over to the Treasurer of the City of Albany, Oregon into a fund designated as the "Sewage Charge Account, Special". The administrative cost rocollecting the sewer charge shall be paid from such special account.

And, further, that Section 5 thereof shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 5. The City of Albany, Dregon may use such means of collection of rates and charges for sever service as may be provided by the laws of the State of Dregon or permitted by the Charter and ordinances of the City of Alban, Oregon, and any delinquencies have be certified to the tax assessor of Linn County for collection in the manner and as provided by Section III of Chapter 289, Oregon Laws 1931. Hates an charges shall be deemed to be delinquent and shall fraw interest it eight per cent per annum. If not haid by the twentieth day of the month, the charge is effective. Any charge due sereunder which shall not be paid when due have be recovered in an action at law by the City of Albany.
