

ORDINANCE NO. 2144

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND MANNER OF HOLDING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, ON THE 20 DAY OF December, 19 49 FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID CITY, FOR THEIR ADOPTION OR REJECTION A PROPOSED CHANGE IN THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY AS SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS BY RESOLUTIONS NOS. 99, 100, 101, 102, 103 and 104 ADOPTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OCTOBER 12, 1949.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That in the manner provided by law and this ordinance and for the purpose set forth herein, a special election shall be held in the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 20 day of December, 19 49, commencing at the hour of 8 o'clock a.m. and continuing until 5:00 p.m. of said day.

Section 2. The following are hereby designated as the voting places of said election within the city:

FIRST WARD

Maple Street School

SECOND WARD

American Legion Hall, Fifth and Lyon St.

THIRD WARD

Albany High School

SECTION 4. The judges and clerks shall qualify by subscribing to an oath in the manner and form provided by law, and in case any of such officers shall fail to attend, then those present shall elect another to act in his place.

Section 5. The City Recorder shall cause notice of said election to be given by publication thereof in the Albany Democrat Herald, a newspaper of general circulation published in said City of Albany, Oregon, once a week for four successive weeks, the first publication to be not less than thirty (30) days previous to the date of the election. Said notice shall state the time, voting places and the purpose of the election.

Section 6. The ballot title of the proposed Charter Amendment submitted to the voters as provided in Resolution No. 99 shall be as follows:

PROPOSITION FOR THE ANNEXATION OF A CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON SUBMITTED BY THE COUNCIL OF SAID CITY

Territory 1.

Beginning at the point on the western boundary line of the city limits of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, where the southern boundary line of the Masonic Cemetery, if extended easterly, intersects the west boundary line of the city limits of Albany, Oregon, and running thence westerly from said point and along the south line of the Masonic Cemetery a distance of 200'; running thence southerly to the northeast corner of Block 1 in Sprenger Supplemental Plat to Hazelwood, Linn County, Oregon; thence westerly along the north line of Block 1 to a point to where the midline of Block 13, Hazelwood Addition, if extended north would intersect such line; running thence southerly and parallel to the east line of Sprenger Supplemental Plat to Hazelwood Addition to the center of Block 13, Hazelwood Addition to the city of Albany, Oregon; running thence southerly in the center of said Block 13 and continuing through the center of Block 12 and to the midpoint on the south boundary line of Block 11; running thence westerly along the south boundary line of Block 11 and along the south boundary line of Block 10 of said addition to the southwest corner of Block 16; running thence southerly to the northwest corner of Block 17 in said addition; running thence westerly and along the north line of Block 24 to the center of said block; running thence southerly through the center of said Block 24 and continuing southerly to the center of Block 23; running thence westerly along the center of Block 23 and continuing westerly through the midline of Block 25 and Block 30 in said Hazelwood Addition to the midpoint of the west boundary line of said Block 30; running thence southerly along the west boundary line of Block 30 and to the northwest corner of Block 29; running thence westerly and along the north boundary line of Block 31 in said addition to the midline on the north boundary line of said block; running thence southerly through the center of Block 31 and continuing parallel to the west line of Marion Street to where this line intersects the south boundary line of Hazelwood Addition, being a point in Block 32; running thence easterly on the south boundary of Hazelwood Addition to a point where it intersects the north line of the County Road; running thence in a northeasterly direction along the north boundary line of said County Road to the point where it intersects the west line of Broadway; running thence in a northeasterly direction to the southwest corner of Block 1, Albany Heights Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon; running thence northerly along the east line of Broadway to the point of beginning.

PROPOSITION FOR THE ANNEXATION OF A CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, SUBMITTED BY THE COUNCIL OF SAID CITY

Territory 2.

Beginning at the southwest corner of the presently constituted city limits which is the southwest corner of the Bureau of Mines' property and running thence west a distance of 260 feet; running thence northerly and parallel with the presently constituted city limits to a point where this line if extended would intersect the north boundary line of the County Road which is known as the South Albany-Corvallis Road which point is on the south boundary line of Hazelwood Addition; running thence northeasterly along the north line of said County Road to where it intersects the west line of Broadway and running thence northeasterly to the southwest corner of Block 1, Albany Heights Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon; running thence southerly along the present west city limits of the City of Albany which is the west boundary line of Bureau of Mines' property to the point of beginning.

Shall the above described territory be annexed to the City of Albany, Oregon:

The ballot title of the proposed Charter Amendment submitted to the voters as provided in Resolution No. 101 shall be as follows:

PROPOSITION FOR THE ANNEXATION OF A CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, SUBMITTED BY THE COUNCIL OF SAID CITY

Territory 3.

Beginning at a point which is the intersection of the southerly line of the City of Albany with the east line of the Highway which is an extension of Elm Street; and running thence southerly along the west boundary line of said highway to a point where it intersects the north line of Kouck's Addition to the City of Albany and running thence westerly along the north line of Kouck's Addition and continuing westerly along a line if the north line of Kouck's Addition were extended to where it intersects the present limits of the City of Albany, being on the east line of the property now known as the Bureau of Lines; running thence northerly along the city limits as now constituted to an interior angle where the city limits intersect and running thence easterly along the presently constituted southerly limits of the city to the point of beginning.

PROPOSITION FOR THE ANNEXATION OF A CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, SUBMITTED BY THE COUNCIL OF SAID CITY

Territory 4.

Beginning at the most southerly southeast corner of Block 5 in Ripe's South Albany Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon where the same intersects the westerly boundary line of Highway 99E; running thence southerly along the westerly boundary line of said Highway 99E to where it intersects the south boundary line of Block 20, South Albany Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon; running thence westerly along the south boundary line of said Block 20 and continuing to where the south boundary line if extended intersects the west line of the Highway which is generally known as the extension of Elm Street; running thence northerly along the west boundary line of said Highway which is known as the extension of Elm Street to a point which is the present boundary line of the City of Albany and is the westerly extension of the south boundary line of Block 4, Schultz Front Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon; running thence easterly along the south line of said Block 4 in Schultz Front Addition and along the said south line of Block 4 and continuing easterly along the south boundary line of Block 5 of Ripe's South Albany Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon to the intersection with the west boundary line of 99E, which is the point of beginning.

Beginning at the northeast corner of the Hiram Smead D.L.C. No. 53 in T 11 S.R. 3 W. of the W.M., Linn County, Oregon; running thence south 1 deg. 30 min. east along the said line No. 53 a distance of 1759.05 feet; thence south 28 deg. 30 min. west 375.54 feet; thence north 1 deg. 30 min. west to the south boundary line of Block 13 in the Spauline Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon which is the north boundary of the street now known as Queen Avenue; running thence easterly along the north line of Queen Avenue to a point north 1 deg. 30 min. W. of the northeast corner of the Hiram Smead D.L.C. No. 53 and running thence south 1 deg. 30 min. east to the northeast corner of the Hiram Smead D.L.C. No. 53.

Beginning at a point on the north line of Queen Avenue where the east line of Birky and Bean Addition to Hollywood Acres, an addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, if extended northerly intersects the north line of Queen Avenue; running thence southerly along the east line of Birky and Bean Addition to Hollywood Acres and to the southeast corner of said addition; ~~running thence southerly along an extension of said east line and along the east line of said Birky and Bean Addition to Hollywood Acres and to the southeast corner of said addition;~~ running thence westerly along the south boundary line of Block 4 of said addition to the southwest corner of said Block 4; running thence southerly along the east boundary line of 3, Main along the west line of Block 1 and Block 2 and continuing southerly along the east boundary of Block 6 and Block 7, all in Lorningside Tracts, an addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, and continuing southerly to a point on the north line of Block 14, Lorningside Tracts; running thence westerly along the north boundary line of said Block 14 and running thence northerly to a point which is the easterly extension of South line of Block 21, Daily and Kelly Supplemental Plat to Hollywood Acres, an addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, and running thence westerly along the south line of Block 21 and continuing westerly and along the north line of Block 15 and westerly along the north line of Block 16 of Daily and Kelly Supplemental Plat to Hollywood Acres; running thence northerly along the west boundary line of Block 9 of Hollywood Acres to the northwest corner of Block 9 of Hollywood Acres; running thence westerly to the southwest corner of the property owned by School District No. 5, Linn County, Oregon, which point is 207.50 feet S. 1 deg. 30 Min. E. from the northeast corner of the Hiram Wood S.L.P., running thence north 1 deg. 30 Min. W. along the east line of the School District No. 5, Linn County, Oregon and to the point where such line intersects the north boundary line of Queen Avenue; running easterly along the north boundary line of Queen Avenue to the place of beginning.
