

ORDINANCE NO. 2155

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE AUDITING OF THE BOOKS AND ACCOUNTS AND RECORDS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That at the beginning of each fiscal year, July 1st, the Council of the said City of Albany shall employ a competent accountant or accountants to audit all books, accounts and records of said City for the previous year as kept by the several offices thereof. Said accountant or accountants after having audited all said books, accounts and records, shall make a written report of his or their findings to the Council.

Section 2. Said accountant or accountants shall receive for services such a sum as may be agreed upon with the Council and shall be paid from the General Fund of said City in like manner as other claims against the City are paid.

Section 3. Whereas the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany are involved, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
