

ORDINANCE NO. 2159

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL IN ITS ENTIRETY ORDINANCE NO. 870 passed by Council July 26, 1916 WHICH IS AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR THE OWNERS OR PERSONS IN CONTROL OF, OR AGENTS FOR, PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, SUPPLIED WITH SEWER FACILITIES, TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN, OR USE WATER CLOSETS OR PRIVIES THEREON WITHOUT CONNECTING THE SAME WITH LATERAL SEWERS: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 870 as passed by council July 26, 1916 and approved by the Mayor July 26, 1916 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
