## CRITINANCE NO. 2203

AN CRUMANCE to determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the council of the City of Albany has determined to make in Resolution No. 148 adopted by said council on the 26th day of Aril. 1950 on the Alley between Third and Fourth Avenues from the west line of Elloworth Street to the east line of Broadalbin in the City of Albany, Gregor; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of ack probable cost of such improvement of said street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 26th day of Aril, 1950, the council of the City of Albany, Oregon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said city to make plans and specifications for the improvement of the Alley between Third and Fourth Avenues from the west line of Ellsworth Street to the east line of Broadalbin, in the following manner, to-wit:

1. Grade and gravel

2. Paving with suitable hard surface

3. Necessary gutter for proper drainage

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said postion of said street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said city, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 117" and adopted on the 26th day of April, 1950.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 147 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 147 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 26th day of April, 1950.

WHEREAS, the Council on the 26th day of April, 1950 by Resolution No. 148 duly adopted by said council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said council proposed to improve the Alley between Third and Fourth Avenues from the west line of Ellsworth Street to the east line of Broadalbin in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 148, and

WHEREAS, in and by said Resolution No. 148 adopted as aforesaid by the council, the Recorder of said city was duly ordered and directed by said council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said street as provided by the Charter of said city, and

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the council of said of did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said street in the manner provided by the Charter of said city, no legal remonstrances having been interposed, and

WHEREAS, the said council in and by said Resolution No. 148 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 148 to be the sum of \$1,954,10.

#### THEREFORE

#### THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Allay between Third and Fourth Avenues from the west line of Ellsworth Street to the east line of Broadalbin in the City of Albany, Oregon be improved as follows:

1. Grade and gravel

2. Paving with suitable hard surface

3. Necessary gutter for proper drainage

all in accordance with said Resolution No. 148 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 26th day of April, 1950.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said street in the manner heretofore determined by the council of Albany in and by Resolution No. 148 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said street and computing any surplus or deficit that might arise by reason of credits for previous work done or additional work that might have been encountered, is hereby declared to be the sum of \$1,954.10.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said a treet assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street to be improved as a foresaid and as determined by said council in and by said Resolution No. 148 is hareby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the asparate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
