CRIDINANCE NO. 2205

AN COUNTAINED to determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the council of the City of Albany has determined to make in Mesclution No. 118 adopted by said council on the 26th day of April 1950 on Eighth Avenue from the east side of Columbus Street to the west side of Clay Street, Ninth Avenue from the east side of Columbus Street to the west mide of Clay Street, Columbus Street from the south side of the new Pacific Highway to the north side of Santiam Highway and Clay Street from the north side of Santiam Highway to the north side of Eighth Avenue in the City of Albany, Oregon; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said streets that is a suessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

MARRIES on the 26th day of April 1950 the council of the City of Albany, Oregon duly. adopted a resolution requiring the City angineer of said city to make plans and specifications for the improvement of eighth Avenue from the east side of Columbus Street to the west side of Clay Street, Ninth Avenue from the east side of Columbus Street to the west side of Clay Street, Columbus Street from the south side of the new Panific highway to the north side of Santiam Highway and Clay Street from the north side of Santiam Highway to the north side of Eighty avenue, in the following manner, to-wit:

- 1. Asphalt concrete paving.
- 2. Sid swalks, where needed.
 3. Gurb and gutters and drainage, where needed.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said streets and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said city, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 117" and a douted on the 26th day of April 1950.

WHIGHAS the City Engineer of said City of Albeny pursuant to said Resolution No. 117 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said streets in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 117 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 26th day of April 1950.

WHENDAS the Council on the 26th day of April, 1950 by Resolution No. 118 duly adopted by said council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said council proposed to improve Eighth Avenue from the east side of Columbus Street to the west side of Clay Street, Hinth avenue from the east side of Columbus Street to the west side of Clay Street, Columbus Street from the south side of the new Facific Highway to the north side of Santiam Highway and Clay Street from the north side of Santiam Highway to the north side of Eighth Avenue in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 118, and

WHENEAS, in and by said Resolution No. 118 adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said city was duly ordered and directed by said council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said street as provided by the Charter of said city, and

WHEREAS the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the council of said City did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said streets in the canner provided by the Charter of said city, and no legal remonstrances having been interposed, and

MME .mS, the said council in and by said Resolution No. 118 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of makin; said improvement of said street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of saids treets to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 118 to be the sum of \$18,623.61.

THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLICIB!

Section 1. That Eighth Avenue from the east side of Columbus Street to the west side of Clay Street, Einth Avenue from the east side of Columbus Street to the west side of Clay Street, Columbus Street from the south side of the new Facific Highway to the north side of Sentian Highway and Clay Street from the north side of Santian Highway to the north side of Highth Avenue, in the City of Albany, Oregon be improved as follows:

- Asphalt concrete paving.
- Sidewalks, where needed.
- 3. Curb and gutters and drainage, where needed.

all in accordance with said Resolution No. 118 and the plane and specifications for said improvement filed by the City ingineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 26th day of April 1950.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said streets in the manner heretofore determined by the council of Albany in and by Resolution No. 118 to be paid by the comers of the real property adjacent to said portion of said streets and computing any surplus or deficit that might arise by reason of credits for previous work done or additional work that might have been encountered, is hereby declared to be the sum of \$18,623.61.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said streets assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said streets to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said countil in and by said Resolution No. 118 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
