

ORDINANCE NO. 321A

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR PERMANENT PARKING SPACE IN THE CITY OWNED LOT BETWEEN ELLSWORTH AND LYON STREETS.

WHEREAS request from group of residents who use the streets for parking and who as part of their business are daily required to use their automobiles in serving the public, have requested that they be allowed the privilege of a parking space in the city owned lot which shall be exclusively used for their particular automobile and that they will pay for such privilege in advance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There shall be made available to applicants a parking space in the city owned lot which is located between Ellsworth and Lyon Street, just south of Water Avenue in the City of Albany, Oregon, which space shall be used exclusively for the particular vehicle that they might own and register; that such space shall be set aside under the direction of the Superintendent of Streets and that such space shall be marked as not being available to the public but shall be available from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. each week day to the automobile whose license number has been registered and shall be the only vehicle permitted to occupy such parking space.

Section 2. That such space shall be allocated upon the written application of the person in form prepared by the City of Albany and which form shall designate the automobile which shall have the use of this particular parking space. That such application shall be accompanied by the payment in advance of six months' rental which rental shall be at the rate of \$5.00 monthly, and the applicant shall be entitled to renew the same upon the payment of a further tender of six months' rental in advance. The right of the occupant to have the exclusive privilege of parking in this particular space can be terminated by an ordinance abolishing such privilege and the parties so dispossessed will be entitled to a return of the proportion of the fee which had not been earned.

Section 3. That such exclusive privilege shall be available only to the automobiles so registered and such identification shall be placed on the parking spot reserved under this automobile to permit its identification by any police officer and the parking of any other automobile in the space reserved, whether it be owned by the applicant or otherwise, shall be a violation of this ordinance and shall be considered as an overtime parking violation and the car may be tagged by the police officer for such violation and such will be the same penalty as is provided for overtime parking under Ordinance No.1681.
