THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO GRDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That in a manner provided by law and in this ordinance and for the purpose set forth herein, a special election shall be held in the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 12th day of Cotober, 1951, commencing at the hour of 3:00 o'clock P. M. of the said day, Facific Standard Time.

The following are hereby designated as the voting places of the said Section 2. election:

FIRST WARD! Haple School

SECOND WARD: High School

THIRD WARD: Madison School

Section 1. That the Judges and clerks of the special election to supervise the election at each of the within wards of the City of Albany shall be as follows:

Section 4: The judges and clerks shall qualify by subscribing to an oath in the manner and for: provided by law and in case any of such officers shall fail to attend then those present shall elect another to act in his place.

The City Recorder shall cause notice of said special election to be given by publication thereof in the Albany Democrat Herald, a newspaper of general circulation, published in the said City of Albany, Oregon, once a week for two successive weeks; first publication to be within thirty days next preceding the date of the special election, said notice shall state the time, voting places and a statement of the substance of the proposed charter wandment.

Section 6: The City Recorder in addition to the notice required by Section 5 shall cause to be posted in ten conspicuous places within each of the three yards at least ten days before the date of the special election, notices of the special election in the following form:

## "BREGIAL ELECTION NOTICE"

Notice is hereby given that on October 12, 1951, at the ( location ) in the Ward in the City of Albany, Oregon, a special election will be held concerning a measure for the amendment to the Charter of the City of Albany, as follows:

'AN ACT TO amend the Charter of the City of Albany, Gregon by amending Chapter XVI to authorize the Mayor and the Council of the City of Albany to construct an interceptor sever, pumping plants, including primary and secondary treatment and such necessary connecting and main storm severs all in an amount not to exceed the aggregate sum of 2750,000.00, the proceeds of which shall be used to pay the cost of the improvements first mentioned. which election will be held at 8:00 o'clock in the morning and will continue until 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon Pacific Standard Time of the said day.

Section 7. At the said special election a proposed amendment to the Chapter of the City of Albany shall be submitted to the legal voters for their adoption or rejection as hereinafter set forth in Section 9.

Section 8. The Recorder shall cause to be printed in pamphlet form a true copy of the title and text of the said measure to be voted upon, together with the number and form in which the same will appear on the official special election ballot and shall mail one of each of said pamphlets to each registered voter in the said City not later than five days before the date of the special election and preceding the copy of the said measure as hereinafter set forth there shall be a statement that the same will be voted upon at a special election to be held on the 12th day of October, 1951, between the hours of 8:00 c'cleck 4. M. and 8:00 o clock P. M., Pacific Standard Time.

Section 9. The ballot title of the proposed Charter Amendment submitted to the voters shall be as follows:

CHARTER AMENDMENT SUBSCITTED TO THE PROPLE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY.

AN ACT to smend the Charter of the City of Albany, Oregon, by amending Chapter XVI to authorize the Mayor and the Council of the City of Albany to issue and sell general obligation bonds of the City, to provide funds to construct an interceptor sewar, pumping plants, including primary and secondary treatment and such necessary connecting and main sewers, all in an amount not to exceed the aggregate sum of \$750,000. the proceeds of which shall be used to pay the cost of the improvements first centioned.

Section 10. The proposed Charter Amendment submitted to the votors shall be as follows and the same shall be printed in the voters pamphlet as follows:

AN ACT to amend Chapter XVI of the Charter of the City of Albany to read as follows:

## CHAPTER XVI.

Section 1. That the City of Ibany is required to divert the flow of sewage from the Willarstte River and into and through a sewage treatment plant. That Ordinance No. 1960, as amended, provides for the levying and payment of a sewer rental charge. That the funds so received have been maintained to defray the cost of the interceptor sewer, sawage treatment plant and the maintenance thereof.

Section 2. That such interceptor sewer, pumping stations, connecting Sewers, main sewers, sanitary and storm sewers and sewage treatment plant both for primary and secondary treatment, shall be constructed within and without the City of Albany, Cregon. The estimated cost of the project as reported by the engineer is \$305,000.00. 'he funds derived from the sewer rental charges now total \$70,000. The sewer rental charges to be collected after the construction of the sewage treatment plant shall be used first to may for the maintenance of such plant and pumping stations, and the remainder shall be applied to the paramet of the pumping stations, and the remainder shall be applied to the paramet of the pumping stations, and the remainder shall be applied to the interest and the repayment of principal of the bonds proposed herein.

Section 3. That for the purpose of providing funds for the construction of such interceptor sever, pumping stations, connecting severs, main severs, astern severs and sevage treatment plant and to pay the engineering, legal and construction costs, the Council of the City of Ilbany, Creron, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute and sell the general obligation bonds of the City in an amount not to exceed the aggregate sum of \$750,000. Such bonds shall be issued from time to time in the manner and in form as provided by law. The Council shall, it the beginning of each budget year, revoide and budget for the maintenance, cost of such plant, pumping stations and interceptor sewer from the rent all charge and the sum estimated as available thereafter from the said sever rental funds shall be applied upon the payment of interest and the principal of these bonds as due. The Council is hereby authorized to lavy sufficient taxes

to pay the belance of the interest thereon and the principal as and when the same becomes due and payable.

Section 11. Inasmuch as the sawage disposal system must of necessity be constructed at the earliest practical date and that it is necessary to accumulate funds through the issuance of bonds to provide for such construction and that it is essential for the health, peach and safety of the People of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
