ORGINANCE NO. 2365

AM CROTICALCE providing for the time and manner of improvement of Allay between 3rd and 4th from Calapocia to Washington

providing how the cret of each improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of alban; by the person or persons taking such improvement if the same shall not be one leted on the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of the said City of notice for bids for the completion of said improvement, and declaring an emergency.

THE PROPILE OF THE CITY OF ALBANT DO URUATH AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Alley between 3rd and 4th from Calapooia to Washington

be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- 1. Grade and gravel
- 2. Drainage 3. Asphalt concrete

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albeny, Oregon and the plane, specifications and estimates for the improvement of said street filed in the office of the Recorder of the said City of Albany on the 25th day of March, 1952.

The cost of making of said improvement shall be paid out of the funds to be collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said street so to be improved as hereinabove described and especially and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the Charter of said City of Albany.

Sale improvement shall be sempled by the 15th day of September, 1952. The City Council reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Any person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albamy for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement and at the came of signing such contract, make, execute and de-liver to said City a good and sufficient bend with sufficient surety thereon to be approved by the hayor of the City of Albany in a sum equal to fifty per cent of the amount to be paid under such contract for the faithful performance thereof.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the City of albany to make said improvement shall not complete the same with-in the time mentioned and specified in such contract, the City of Albany shall be desired to suffer damages on account thereof in the amount of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contrast, which amount shall be paid by such contractor using the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement be axtended by the council.

Section 3. The Escarder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for making of said improvement by publishing such notice is a days in the Albany Democrat-Herald, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing said work of improving said portion of said street.

Section 4. Inacture as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an energency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon to passage by the Council and its approval by the Kayor of the City of Albany.
