## ORDINANCE NO. 2403

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AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY HAS DETERMINED TO MAKE IN RESOLUTION NO. ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 26TH DAY OF MARCH, 1952, FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF QUEEN AVENUE FROM EAST LINE OF ELM STREET TO 99 E

IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON; TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLARE THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PROGABLE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID STREET TO BE SO IMPROVED, TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIENS AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS on the 12th day of March, 1952, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plane and specifications for the improvement of Queen Avenue from east line of Elm street to 99E

in the following manner, to-wit:

1. Curb and gutters

2. Sidewalks

2. Sidewalks
3. Drainage
and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street
and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications,
and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said
City, said resclution being endorsed "Resolution No.240A" and adopted
12th day of March, 1952.

WHEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said
Resolution No.240A made plans, specifications and estimates as directed
by the said resolution for the improvement of said threet in the manner
specified in said Resolution No.240A and filed said plans, specifications
and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 26th day of
March, 1952. March, 1952.

WHEREAS the Council on the 26th day of March, 1952 by Resolution No. 240B duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council, proposed to improve Queen Avenue from east line of Elm street to 99E

in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 240B, and
WHEREAS in and by said Resolution No. 240B adopted as aforesaid by
the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by
said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said atreet
in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 240B, and
WHEREAS the Recorder in pursuence of said order and direction of the

Council of said City did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said street in the marner provided by the Charter of said City, and WHEREAS the Council in and by said Resolution No. 240B ascertained

and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said street to be paid by the ewners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said street to be improved as specified in Resolution No. 2408 to be the sum of \$4,807.82.

## THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO CROAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Queen Avenue from east line of Elm street to 99E

in the City of Albany, Oregon be improved as follows:

TO THE T

1. Curb and gutters

Sidewalks

3. Drainage all in accordance with said Resolution No. 240B and the plans and specifica-

tions for anid improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 26th day of March, 1952.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of Albany in and by Resolution No. 240B to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said street and computing any surplus or deficit that might arise by reason of credits for previous work done or additional work that might have been encountered, is hereby declared to

be the sum of \$4,807.82. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 2408 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
