

ORDINANCE NO. 2461

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A FIVE YEAR CONTRACT FOR THE EXCLUSIVE PRIVILEGE OF COLLECTING AND DISPOSING OF GARBAGE IN THE CITY WITH H. J. MONTANK AND ROBERT L. REAVIS.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for the exclusive contract for the collection and disposal of garbage within the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth, and

WHEREAS, upon motion duly made, seconded and passed, the bid of H. J. MONTANK AND ROBERT L. REAVIS was deemed the most favorable bid.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with H. J. MONTANK AND ROBERT L. REAVIS for the exclusive privilege of collecting and disposing of garbage within the City of Albany, Oregon, said contract to be five years duration commencing January 1, 1953 and ending January 1, 1958; said contract to include substantially the terms and conditions as set forth in Ordinance No. 2141, and the "Conditions of Garbage Contract" as furnished to the respective bidders by the Recorder of the City of Albany under the advertisement of the above mentioned, and

By this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided, and

In as much as the passage of this ordinance is hereby necessary for the peace, health and preservation of the peace of the City of Albany in that the contract is to become effective January 1, 1953, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance is in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
