

ORDINANCE NO. 2468

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CLAY STREET, FROM THE NORTH LINE OF HIGHWAY 99 E TO THE SOUTH LINE OF FOURTH AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did, by resolution number 256 at the Council Meeting on the 14th day of January, set the hour as 7:15 o'clock P.M. on February 25th, 1953, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of CLAY STREET, FROM THE NORTH LINE OF HIGHWAY 99 E TO THE SOUTH LINE OF FOURTH AVENUE more particularly described in the said resolution and did in the said resolution direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law and in the said resolution the people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing, on the 25th day of February, 1953, was duly held and no remonstrance having been filed with the City Recorder and no persons appearing objecting to the proposed vacation

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That CLAY STREET, FROM THE NORTH LINE OF HIGHWAY 99 E TO THE SOUTH LINE OF FOURTH AVENUE, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the south west corner of Block 3 of Supplemental Plat of Burkhart Addition, City of Albany, Oregon; thence northerly along the west line of said Block to the North West Corner of said Block 3; thence westerly along the south boundary line of Fourth Avenue to the north east corner of Block 4, Supplemental Plat, Burkhart Addition, City of Albany, Oregon; thence southerly along the east line of said Block 4, to the south east corner of said Block 4; thence north easterly along the north boundary line of 99 E to the POB.

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany.
