

ORDINANCE NO. 2498

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH DON DENSMOOR CHEVROLET COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE 1953 CHEVROLET IN THE SUM OF \$1566.97 AND WITH NELSON EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE GALION TANDEM ROLLER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3415.25 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for one four-door standard sedan for general and police use, and one gasoline driven tandem roller used in paving operations, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with DON DENSMOOR CHEVROLET COMPANY for the purchase of one 1953 Chevrolet in the sum of \$1566.97, and


with NELSON EQUIPMENT COMPANY for the purchase of one galion tandem roller in the amount of \$3415.25.

By this Ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.


