

ORDINANCE NO. 2573

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MINNESOTA MINING & MANUFACTURING COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore request bids for traffic signs to be installed on the new one-way street system and,

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth, and,

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the council of the City of Albany

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Minnesota Mining & Manufacturing Company of Saint Paul, Minnesota for the purchase of traffic signs at the bid price of \$2,515.35, and,

By this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
