

ORDINANCE NO. 2600

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PAINTING MARKING MACHINE WITH THE NORRIS-WALKER PAINT COMPANY OF SALEM, OREGON IN THE SUM NOT EXCEEDING \$450.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Council of the City of Albany do, by the passage of this Ordinance, deem it impracticable to obtain bids for a Paint Marking Machine.


Section 2: The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a Paint Marking Machine, Model 401, Econo-Liner not to exceed \$450.00 for the street department with the Norris-Walker Paint Company of Salem, Oregon.

By this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

Inasmuch as the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
