

ORDINANCE NO. 2652

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO DISPENSE WITH AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, UNDER 222.120 O.R.S. REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF MORNINGSIDE TRACTS AND THE SOUTHERN ADDITION TO MORNINGSIDE TRACTS TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON; SETTING A TIME FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an election within the City of Albany regarding the annexation of the following described property, to-wit:

All of Morningside Tracts and all of the Southern
Addition to Morningside Tracts

shall be and it is hereby dispensed with pursuant to and under the terms of 222.120 O.R.S.


Section 2: That there shall be a public hearing as to the advisability of annexing the property described in Section 1 to the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 23rd day of May, 1956, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to give notice of the said public hearing by publishing in a newspaper of general circulation published in the said City once a week for two (2) successive weeks, and by posting in four (4) public places a notice setting forth the time and place of the said hearing and the description of the property to be considered for annexation and the purposes for which the hearing is held.


Section 3: Whereas, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment and should the same be annexed, that the cities facilities made available to this property, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
