

ORDINANCE NO. 2674

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE JESKE BROS. CONSTRUCTION CO. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SOUTH INDUSTRIAL AREA SANITARY TRUNK SEWER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for construction of the South Industrial Area Sanitary Trunk Sewer as previously provided by Ordinance No. 2621, and WHEREAS, such bids were received and duly opened at the time therein setforth, and WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany:


THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Jeske Bros. Construction Co. for the construction of the South Industrial Area Sanitary Trunk Sewer as heretofore provided by Ordinance in the total sum of \$119,702.40 according to the bids submitted.


