

ORDINANCE NO. 2717

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE DON DENSMOOR CHEVROLET COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO POLICE PATROL CARS AND ONE FIRE CHIEF'S CAR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for two Police Patrol cars and one Fire Chief's Car for the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Don Densmoor Chevrolet Company of Albany, Oregon, for the purchase of two 1957 V 8 Chevrolets, Series 150, Four Door Sedans at the bid price of \$2,228.00 for the Police Department; one 1957 Chevrolet 210, 6 cylinder, four door Station Wagon at the bid price of \$1,947.00 for the Fire Chief, and making a total balance upon the contract of \$4,175.00, and

By this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.


