

ORDINANCE NO. 2789

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A PORTION OF HAWTHORNE PARK ADDITION, CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of May 1958, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, did duly pass Ordinance No. 2781 wherein it was provided that a Public Hearing would be held on the 11th day of June, 1958, concerning the advisability of annexing a portion of Hawthorne Park Addition, contiguous to the City of Albany, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the hearing was duly held on the 11th day of June 1958, and at that time the Council determined that notices of hearing had been duly given as provided in the said Ordinance and pursuant to the terms of 222.120 ORS, and

WHEREAS, the Council after the said hearing determined that the said portion of Hawthorne Park Addition be annexed to the City of Albany, and the consent of the property owners have been filed giving their consent for the said annexation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described property be and it is hereby annexed to the City of Albany to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the present City Limits of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, which point is 14°12' E. 135 feet more or less from the SW corner of the intersection of Liberty St. and 27th Avenue extended;
thence S. 14°12' E. 310 feet.
thence N. 75°48' E. 60 feet to the East bank of a ditch conveyed to the City of Albany by Deed recorded in Volume 159 on page 174, Deed Records, Linn County, Oregon
thence Northeasterly along the east bank of said ditch to the present City Limits of City of Albany;
thence Westerly along the present City Limits to the point of beginning.

Section 2: Whereas, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and, should the same be annexed, that the City facilities be made available to this property, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
